## The Glow of Friendship

Finished block size 12"x 12"

## Requirements

This block is made from scraps of cool colours and warm coloured fabrics. There is an outline of the block for you to colour and decide the fabric placement. As a guide, you will need:

餉 6 pieces of light, medium and dark blues/turquoise/teals
滕 6 pieces of light, medium and dark pinks/reds
Read the Cutting instructions for the size of each piece.

Hint - cut small pieces of fabric and pin or glue them to the block outline on page 7 to plan your colour placement.

## Cutting

## Block assembly

## Unit 1



Cool


Warm

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a K1 piece. Place piece K1, right sides together with a piece l1.
2. Sew $1 / 4$ " seam on both sides of the drawn line.
3. Cut on the drawn line. Press open towards the darker fabric.
4. Trim squares to $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
5. Repeat steps 1 to 4 using pieces K 2 and I 2 .

Diagram - Making 2 half square triangles at a time

1. Layout pieces A 1 and $\mathrm{I} 1 / \mathrm{K} 1$ half square triangle units.
2. Sew pieces A 1 to a $\mathrm{l} 1 / \mathrm{K} 1$ half square triangle units. Press towards A1.
3. Sew Unit 1 together. Press open seam.
4. Make 1 - Unit 1 measuring $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
5. Repeat steps 1 to 4 for the warm Unit 1.


## Unit 2

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a L1 piece. Place it right sides together on the left side of a piece B1.
2. Sew on drawn line.
3. Trim block $1 / 4$ from drawn line.
4. Press away from B1.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a L1 piece. Place it right sides together on the right side of a piece B1.
2. Sew on drawn line.
3. Trim block $1 / 4$ " from drawn line.
4. Press away from B1.

using pieces B2 and L2.


1. Sew a piece B1 to the L1 / B1 unit. Press seam towards B1.
2. Make 2 unit 2 in total measuring $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square.


Repeat steps for making Unit 2 for warm colours


## Unit 3



1. Finger press strips C1, D1 , D2 and C2 in half to find centre.
2. Sew C1, D1, D2 and C2 together matching the centre fold marking. Press seams open.
3. Place a $41 / 2$ " square ruler over the block, lining up the $45^{\circ}$ ruler marking with the centre seam and the left and right corners with the horizontal fold line.
4. Trim the block.
5. Make 2 - Unit 3 . Unit 3 measures $41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ square.


## Unit 4



1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of piece E1.
2. Place an E1 and E2 pieces right sides together. Sew on the drawn line.
3. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the drawn line. Discard the cut-off. Press towards the darker fabric.
4. Trim half square triangle unit to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
5. Make 1 - half square triangle .

6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a J1 piece. Place piece J1, right sides together with a piece J 2 .
7. Sew $1 / 4$ " seam on both sides of the drawn line.
8. Cut on the drawn line. Press open towards the darker fabric.
9. Trim squares to $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

10. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a F1 piece. Place it right sides together on the left side of a piece H 1 .
11. Sew on drawn line.
12. Trim block $1 / 4$ " from drawn line.
13. Press away from H 1 .
14. Repeat steps 1 to 4 on right side of piece H 1 .
15. Make 2 - flying geese units measuring $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Repeat for other half of unit 4 block using pieces F 2 and H 2 .


1. Lay out the block as shown in Diagram - Unit 4 layout.
2. Sew units together to make rows.
3. Sew rows together.
4. Press seams in direction of arrows.


Diagram - Unit 4 layout

1. Lay out the block as shown in Diagram - Block layout.
2. Sew units together to make rows.
3. Sew rows together.
4. Press seams in direction of arrows.
5. Unfinished block will measure $121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
